**PRESENT:** Esther Terry, James Roberts, Henry Durham, Jr. Yarbrough Williams Dr. Cosmos George, Carolyn Ross Holmes, Laura Zee representing Democracy NC, Virginia Broach, Debbie Formyduval. Steven Mullenix and John Mooring were absent.

Chair Esther Terry called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM

Chair Terry led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Henry Durham made a motion to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by James Roberts and passed 3-0.

Chair Terry called for Citizen comments. Dr. George asked the board to consider placement of a drop box for return of mail absentee ballots to the Warren County Board of Elections due to COVID -19 concerns. Carolyn Ross Holmes echoed the sentiments of Dr. George.

Chair Terry thanked the citizens for their comments.

James Roberts made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 07, 2020 meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Henry Durham and passed 3-0.

Chair Terry then asked Director Formyduval to share any additional information available with the board and citizens along with the Director's Report. (See attached amendment to Director's Report). Director Formyduval indicated that hand delivered ballots must be checked in via a log book when returned to the county board office. She indicated that a curbside call bell system could be used to alert staff that someone is available to meet them at their car to receive their mail absentee ballot.

Prior to the close of the meeting, Laura Zee thanked the Board for their efforts to serve the voters of Warren County.

Chair Esther Terry adjourned the meeting at 9:30 AM.

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**DIRECTOR'S REPORT**  
**WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS**

**ELECTION PROGRAMMING:** During this period staff have been fully engaged in preparation for November 3, 2020. Tasks on the radar at this time have and continue to include:

1. Ordering and receiving PPE for the November 3, 2020 Presidential Election.
2. Planning and preparing additional one stop early voting sites at Vaughan Elementary and the Norlina Fire Station annex building including installation of a VPN network and internet. Final install of internet was completed on 8/31/2020 at the Norlina Fire Station and testing was completed.
3. Ordering laptops and printers for the new early voting sites.
4. Hiring staffing for the early voting period.
5. Making an initial approval of ballots for the Presidential Election. Ballots will be ready by the first week of September. Sample ballots are available at the Board of Elections and will be online with the NCSBE soon.
6. Submitting and receiving approval of the Warren BOE One Stop voting Plan by the NCSBE. Copies of the operational hours are available at the Board of Elections office and on the county website.
7. Receiving mail absentee ballot request forms from voters and adding to a que for processing once ballots are available in early September. Our office has received over 800 requests for mail absentee ballots. We expect to see those numbers rise after voters receive their voter guide from the SBOE in the coming weeks.
8. One staff member has been assigned the task of tracking of COVID related purchases and preparing invoicing for SBOE.
9. Perform list maintenance of voter records-DHHS, DOC and other related.
10. Addressing voter concerns via phone calls, emails and walk in.
11. Setting up ballot printing in-house.
12. Responding to public records request from various groups.
13. Contact with individuals to work one stop as well as Election Day.
14. Preparing training materials for early voting staff in addition to election day precinct officials. We will have quite a few new one stop staff and we are trying to have a mix of seasoned early voting staff working alongside of the new ones.

**BUDGET:** Our office has worked closely with the county finance office to ensure that all PPE was properly coded and to date we have requested reimbursement from the NCSBOE for materials that are in place. Some items are on back order due to the need being so tremendous across the state, however, vendors have assured us that we will have in place in time for the election. The NCSBOE was able to purchase some items through state contract such as hand sanitizer, pens and q-tips for touching voting equipment.
