By all accounts, Warren and Vance Counties were largely spared significant damage from Hurricane Matthew. However, if you experienced damage to crops, farm equipment or farm buildings, kindly report it to us ASAP. The disaster recovery information below may not apply to you, but perhaps it is good food for thought about future preparations, or can be shared with others who have been more directly impacted.

#### **FLOODED SOYBEANS**

#### **MARKETING FLOODED CROPS**

Farmers are advised that crops that have been in contact with flood waters (i.e. crops flooded with water from rivers, creeks or streams) may not be sold for human consumption.
