

**MINUTES FROM A PUBLIC HEARING TO HEAR CITIZENS COMMENTS CONCERNING A PROPOSED “SOLAR FARM ORDINANCE” FOR NON-ZONED AREAS OF WARREN COUNTY HELD BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF WARREN IN THE WARREN COUNTY ARMORY CIVIC CENTER MEETING ROOM ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2016 AT 5:45 P.M.**
