

**MINUTES FROM A JOINT MEETING WITH THE HALIWA SAPONI INDIAN TRIBAL COUNCIL HELD BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF WARREN AT THE HALIWA SAPONI SCHOOL ON MARCH 1, 2005 AT 7:00 PM.**

The joint meeting of the Warren County Board of Commissioners and the Haliwa Saponi Indian Tribal Council was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Richardson were present, and Rev. James Rudd & Maynard Ealing of the Tribal Staff.
