
Whereas, community-based projects that place young people in the center of the learning allows young people to learn about community and community development from each other, their elders and also support young people in leadership roles; and

Adopted this the 8th day of September, 2014.




Warren County Local Foods Access

- The purpose of this project was to learn about resources and food that we have in Warren County.




North Carolina A&T Field
