Meeting Minutes – September 11, 2023, at 12pm

Virtual meeting was called to order at 12pm by Cathy Alston-Kearney, Chair.

Attendance was confirmed and quorum was established; see attached.

Program Reviews were as follows:

- **Boys & Girls Club** reported by Tomika Brown Burwell, 21st Century Program Director. Transitions in leadership have taken place. Jacqueline Robinson is the Chief Development Officer for Boys & Girls Club of North Carolina. Willie Boyd requested information on Warren County student participants. See attached information provided.
- **4-H WAY** reported by Paul McKenzie and Noah Henderson that staff hiring has been requested. No service interruption has taken place. Recommendation to network with social workers for staffing suggestions.

Juvenile Court Counselor Report – reported by Nicole Grant. Written report provided. See attached. Discussion took place on the referral process of assisting agencies and how youth reach Juvenile Court.

Central Area Consultant, Eddie Crews reports:

- Implemented funding plan covers a 2-year period; FY24 & FY25.
- 200 gun locks are available for distribution from various county government locations to include Animal Arch, Parks and Recreation, Health Department, Social Services, and 4-H Way. DPS flyers on safe storage of firearms will be made available. It was noted that the offering of gun locks has not been publicized.
- Orientation for new members will be forthcoming.

 - Risk & Needs committee - Marion Richards, Rev. Willie Boyd, Kateisha Jones, and Brittley Harris

- Discussion took place on recommendation for resuming in-person meetings or hybrid meeting with Zoom or phone line provision.
