POSITION: Utilities Crew Leader

DUTIES: Supervises assigned personnel engaged in the application of techniques, methods and processes to increase the efficiency of Warren County's Public Utilities Systems; Coordinates completion of service requests between property owners, contractors and employees; Reads meters; installs, repairs and replaces sewer and water lines; completes assigned work orders; exercise, flush and clean valves, hydrants, and lines; inspect and perform general maintenance on pumps, motors, machinery and equipment. Cleans work area and vehicles; etc. Position is exposed to inside and outside environmental conditions such as extreme cold and heat, noise, etc.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: At least one year of supervisory experience in public utilities or related field. High school diploma or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Heavy lifting is required. Prior experience is preferred in excavation equipment operations for repairing water & sewer lines & making water & sewer taps.
